Merit Certificates

Just a quick reminder about how the Merit Certificate system works:

- When a child achieves a certificate (e.g. their Bronze) a text will be sent home by the Friday pre-ceding the Wednesday assembly that it will be awarded in. This is so parents can come in to assembly to see their child being presented with the certificate if they so wish.
 - To give parents enough notice we make sure this text is sent by the Friday. Children may come home saying they have reached enough merits to get a certificate but please remember it takes time to process these certificates. Unless you get a text the Friday before, your child won't be getting their certificate on any given Wednesday.

GOING FOR GOALS

Thank you for supporting this event so well. Now we need to follow up from 'Going For Goals' to ensure this initiative has a positive impact on the children's learning. Your child may ask to practice their 'Wishes' at home, especially if it's a mental maths target like a times table. If we, at school, feel a child has achieved their 'Wish' we will present the child with a 'Going For Goals' certificate. Your child will then identify another new goal for themselves in consultation with their teacher and set to work to achieve that. If you at home feel they have achieved their 'Wish' please drop a note/email to their teacher. So please do what you can at home to help your child practice the 'Wish' they have chosen and we look forward to sending lots of 'Going For Goals' certificates home.
