

You also have a chance to briefly meet your child's teacher although this is not a parent consultation evening.


We request that children stay at home, if at all possible, but do understand if child care cannot be arranged. We would rather you came with them than not at all. Thank you.






Alice In Wonderland

Welcome to our church of St Peter

Prayer and Worship St Peter's church is open for private prayer daily. If you see the gate open, feel free to step inside. We have a variety of services to suit everyone:



Especially for Families in the Parishes

If you are looking for something fresh, why not come to our popular "Short and Sweet" family worship? It is held on the **2nd Sunday** of every month here in Cowfold. "Short" because it starts at 10am and lasts for 30 minutes, and "Sweet" because the service is followed by refreshments.

A special service is held at St Peter's Church, at 10am on the **1st Sunday** of each month, for people of all ages and stages



As well as our regular Sunday Eucharist Service, we also have a short midweek Communion Service at 10am **every Wednesday**



Although we don't have a structured Sunday School at St Peter's, we do have "Church in a Box" at all our main services where children can dip into a box of themed activities and books. These are changed weekly.



Taize worship by candlelight is held at Cowfold on every **3rd Sunday** of the month at 6pm. This is a special time for simple chants, and quiet meditation on short passages of scripture.

Father Keith and Father Martin are available for pastoral concerns.

Fr Martin's duty days are Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday.
