#### Would you like to be a Governor of St Peter's CE Primary School?

## **Poppy Planting**

Members of the St Peter's church congregation recently assisted a group of St Peter's pupils as they planted poppies and forget-me-nots at the grave of Harry Elphick to remember him on the centenary of his death in World War 1.

ORDERLY HARRY ELPHICK - British Red Cross Society - Died from illness 14th April 1916 Harry Elphick was enrolled as an Orderly with the British Red Cross Society on 27th December 1915 and served with the Sussex/5 Detachment. He died of double pneumonia at the Royal Victoria Hospital (Netley), Southampton on 14th April 1916 and is buried in Cowfold churchyard with his wife Jane Ann. He was 48 years of age.
