This year our Key Stage 2 Production is The Rocky Monster Show. Performances will take place at **7pm** on the evenings of **Wednesday 13th July and Thursday 14th July.** A letter about arrangements for tickets will follow after half term but please do keep one of those evenings free for this exciting event!

RE: Costumes for our production of The Rocky Monster Show

All the children in Year 6 and some of the children in Year 5 have a speaking role or are involved in the technical running of the show. By now, the children know their role and should have brought their script home to learn their part.

The rest of Year 3, 4 and 5 will be in the chorus of ghosts, ghouls and monsters.

We would really appreciate support from home with providing a costume for your child. We require the costumes in school on a **named** hanger by **Monday 11th July** for our dress rehearsal.

NAMED PARTS - Attached to this letter are the costume requirements for each character. If you have any problems sourcing a costume for your child please contact Mrs Wilson or Mrs Bateman.

CHORUS – Year 3, 4 and 5 (in the chorus) can dress up as a ghost, ghoul or monster. The nature of this can be as simple as wearing a set of casual clothes with the child's face painted green. Or, if they have dressing up stuff at home, they may wish to wear that. Please bear in mind that it could be hot and the children have to sing, so over the face/head full masks are not advised.

We request all face painting be done at home before coming back to school to perform. There will not be capacity for staff to paint chorus pupils' faces. Therefore, this only needs to be done before the two performances and not for the dress rehearsal.

We are also in need of the following props. If you have any of these items and don't mind the children using them in the production, we would be extremely grateful if you could bring them into school:

- Lantern
- Old fashioned suitcase x 2
- Chemistry set
- Dry ice machine
- Lab coats
