Curriculum Time Allocation

There's no set teaching hours for any phase

Maintained schools need enough time to cover the content set out in the national curriculum.

Academies need enough time to allow for a broad and balanced curriculum, including English, mathematics, science and religious education. That's explained here.

So long as you can meet those requirements, it's up to you to determine how much teaching time will be appropriate for your pupils. We were told this by the DfE.

Therefore, we started by calculating how much time we spend on English and Maths at the moment (including Phonics, Spelling 25mins in KS2, Accelerated Reader time). Then, keeping that Maths & English the same (we didn't want to change what we do now with those), we worked out a logical allocation of time left based on subject importance and ensuring we felt enough time was given to each subject to cover The National Curriculum. Proving Adequate Time is Given to all Subjects

• Teachers either draw up your own version of a 2 week timetable.

AND - GIVE IT TO HEADTEACHER AT THE START OF EACH TERM.

When they 'Block' work give the Head a 'one-off' Time Table for that week.

Or they can be more flexible.

But should keep in mind how many hours per academic year need fitting in (see above). Ensure those hours are done — can include cross curricular projects (e.g.2 subjects at once). IN THIS CASE GIVE WEEKLY TIMETABLE TO HEAD AT THE START OF EACH WEEK.
