Overall Outcome

Children will learn about migration over time and people challenged to leave lands they love and thrive in an unfamiliar place. They will develop their resilience by leading a school production, experiencing a week long residential trip, take part in transition and inter-school sporting events and complete end of primary school SATS testing.
