

Sports Funding Report 2020/21

1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021

The school currently receives specific funding to develop the provision for sport at St Peter's School from the government. For the period 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021 the school received **£16,982**.

Carried forward from the 2019/20 Financial Year's Sports Grant was **£2,398**.

Total available to spend = **£19,380**
