Sports Funding Report 2019/20

1st September 2019 to 1st April 2020

The school currently receives specific funding to develop the provision for sport at St Peter's School from the government. For the period September 2019 to March 2020 the school received £9,958.

We also had an accrual at the end of August 2019 of £1,500, carried over to spend.

This gave us a total of £11,458 to spend.
